

# December 2024

## Overview

In December, MAHCP sent a survey to members to gain insight into how allied health professionals are feeling about three key areas: staffing, workload and morale. More than 1,400 members responded, with most seeing setbacks in 2024 and only a small percentage citing any improvement.

**89%**

said staffing has not improved, and nearly half said it is **getting worse**.



**62%**

said their workload has increased throughout the past year.



**92%**

said morale has either not improved or gotten worse in 2024.
