- A recommendation from one of the following – teacher, employer, counselor, or supervisor.
- A resume outlining activities such as volunteer work, community work, extra-curricular activities.
- A 450-500 word essay on why you chose an allied health profession.
- Proof of application to post-secondary education program or letter of acceptance **must** be included.

Applications must be received or postmarked in full by April 22 at 10 am or they will not be considered.
