JOB SUMMARY: This position is responsible for the development, planning, and coordination of programs and projects, on sexuality and reproductive health related issues. The Brandon-Assiniboine Regional Development Coordinator coordinates programming in Brandon, and surrounding area, coordinates program intake, liaises with partners and community, and supports overall SERC programming and program reporting. This position will also be able to fulfil the duties of a Sexuality & Reproductive Health Facilitator and is a member of the SERC leadership team and works closely with coordinators, managers, directors, and staff to identify priority populations and implement agency goals using appropriate community development models.

- Experience working in a cross-cultural context

- Valid Manitoba driver's license and access to a vehicle an asset

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assess community needs and trends, and develop strategies for program and policy development
- Coordinates program intake
- Design and implementation of projects and/or programs
- Contribute to fund development
- Provide consultation to staff on program development and implementation

- Problem solve general operational and staffing issues as they arise and request support from management as required
- Participate and take leadership in the agency communication strategies as assigned
- Participate and collaborate on program and project evaluations and assessments
